IMPORTANT AIRPORT INFORMATION

- Check with your assigned airline regarding luggage fees.
- Empower Peace will not cover luggage fees.
- Be sure to know airline carry-on restrictions (most allow 1 carry-on bag and a personal item).



- VISA INTERVIEWS/PASSPORTS
 - -Contact your US Embassy ASAP to schedule your interview.
 - -You should get a TOURIST/ VISITOR VISA (B-2)
 - -You will need to complete the DS-160 form online.



- VISA INTERVIEWS/PASSPORTS
 - -Empower Peace will not cover Passport or VISA fees.
 - -If you do not have your passport already, please apply for your passport ASAP. You may not be able to obtain it at this point.



- Empower Peace staff will be at Boston's Logan International Airport to greet you upon arrival.
- Empower Peace staff will have W2W signs at the airport.
- We will travel with you to Wheelock College.
- Wheelock College is located approximately 20-30 minutes from airport.



 Luggage - do not bring more than you can personally carry.

 International and domestic flights have luggage weight restrictions and bag fees. Check with your airline.



- Keep a copy of your travel itinerary with you.
- Keep a copy of W2W staff phone numbers with you.
- Keep your luggage check-in receipt with you. If your luggage is lost, you will need this number.
